

## N-400 APPLICATION FOR NATURALIZATION

Application Fee: **\$640**

Fingerprint Fee: **\$85** (not required for applicants over age 75.)

Total Fee: **\$725.00** (applicants between 18 and 75)

- Complete and sign **Form N-400**  
Only the form dated 12/23/2016 will be accepted. (Look on the lower left hand corner of the form to check)
- Attach the required **fee** or fee-waiver form if eligible

### ATTACH THESE DOCUMENTS TO THE N-400 IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Photocopy of the front and back of your permanent resident card (**green card**)
  - Photocopy of **ALL** pages of your **most recent** passport and/or travel document.
  - If you have been married, divorced or widowed since becoming a permanent resident, submit photocopies of the **marriage certificate, divorcee decree, or death certificate**, whichever is applicable. If in a foreign language, include a full certified English translation.
  - If your current legal name is different from the name on your green card, submit photocopies of the documents that legally changed your name (photocopies of the **marriage certificate, divorce decree, or court document**)
  - If you have minor children who do not live with you, submit proof of financial support (photocopies of **cancelled checks, receipts, court order of withholding from your paycheck, a letter from county official indicating you are making payments, or a notarized letter from the child's guardian**)
  - If you are a male born after 01/01/1960, who is currently between the ages of 18 and 26 or who was between the ages of 18 and 26 when you arrived in the U.S., submit a photocopy of your Selective Service Registration or a written statement indicating why you failed to register along with a letter from Selective Service.   - If you have taken a trip outside the United States that lasted six months or more since becoming a Permanent Resident, additional documentation is required. For more information visit [www.uscis.gov](http://www.uscis.gov) or consult a local immigration lawyer.
  - If you owe any taxes, submit a copy of your tax payment plan. For more information visit [www.usics.gov](http://www.usics.gov)
  - If you have ever been arrested or charged with a criminal offense, submit certified copies of the complaint and final disposition regarding all arrests and/or convictions. For more information, consult an immigration lawyer.
  - If you are applying for naturalization on the basis of marriage to a U.S. citizen, additional documentation is required. Visit [www.uscis.gov](http://www.uscis.gov) for more information.
